## Criteria for Accelerated Reader™ Reader Certification Levels

Reader Certification levels in Accelerated Reader are motivating benchmarks for students. They can help students with transitional phases in reading, such as moving from picture books to chapter books, or can help encourage students to broaden their reading experiences. Accelerated Reader keeps track of students' certification levels (except for Honours Reader). Progress can be monitored using AR™ reports, such as the Diagnostic Report, TOPS Report, Reader Certification Level Report and Target History Report. Readers may recertify at a level up to five times, with the exception of Independent Reader, which students achieve only once and which must be teacher-approved in the software before students can move on to higher levels. Accelerated Reader also provides certificates that you can print out to acknowledge students when they reach their targets.

The following table lists the criteria for each level.

## **Ready Reader Advanced Reader** Accumulate 5 AR points on books Read To, Read With Read independently and pass Reading Practice and/or Read Independently. Quizzes for 3 books at a 3.0 book level or higher worth 2 or more points each. Independent Reader Star Reader Read independently and pass Reading Practice Read independently and pass Reading Practice guizzes for 3 books at a 1.2 book level or higher. Quizzes for 3 books at a 4.0 book level or higher worth Accumulate 10 points. Points may include books Read 4 or more points each. To and/or Read With, but only the three books read independently at a 1.2 level or higher count towards the three-book target. Points earned for Ready Reader are not included. **Rising Reader Classic Reader** Read independently and pass Reading Practice Read independently and pass Reading Practice quizzes for 3 books at a 1.6 book level or higher. Quizzes for 3 books at a 6.0 level or higher worth 7 or Accumulate 10 points in independent reading. Only the more points each. books read independently at a 1.6 level count towards the three-book target. Super Reader **Honours Reader** Read independently and pass Reading Practice Read, pass Reading Practice Quizzes, and accumulate Quizzes for 3 books at a 2.0 book level or higher worth 100 points for books on a list of challenging literature that a teacher creates. Teachers must manually keep 1 or more points each. track of student progress towards this level by monitoring TOPS Reports or the Student Record Report.

Students must achieve the minimum scores set in the preferences area of the software for quiz results to count towards certification. The default preference is to require 60 per cent on 5- and 10-question guizzes and 70 per cent on 20-question quizzes. This may be changed to 80 per cent for all quizzes.
