Daily / Weekly

- **Reading:** please read with your child every day and ask them questions to check they understand what they are reading.
 - **Mathletics:** weekly tasks will continue to be set to support the learning we are doing in class.
- Spellings:** spelling words will be sent home at the start of half term, supporting the spelling patterns we will be learning in class.

Topic related activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

- Make a survey to find out why people choose to live where they do and what features they think are important. Ask your family, friends and neighbours!
- Visit a town or city and compare this with Cambridge. Why do you think people choose to live where they do?
- Plan a journey using a map, then go on this journey using your map!
- Go on a treasure hunt or make a treasure hunt for someone (Perhaps have a go at geocaching).
- Visit Cambourne and record:
 - What types of buildings are there and what they are used for?
 - Whether it is busy
 - How traffic is controlled
 - Watch traffic for 5 minutes. What vehicles do you see and how many? Keep a tally.
- How could you improve the area in which you live? What ideas do you have?
- Explain how your life would be different if you lived in a different place. Why not write a diary entry of a day in a life of you but living somewhere else.
- Go for a long walk using a map to guide your family.
- Investigate different buildings around the world. Which building is your favourite and why?
- Design your own village, town or city (A good opportunity to use some Lego!).
