This half term we will be focusing on the following spelling patterns:

Spelling focus	Example words
Suffix – ous	fabulous, enormous, serious, curious
Ei, eigh, ey	vein, reign, weight, they, obey
Y elsewhere than at the end of a word	<i>myth, gym, Egypt, pyramid, mystery</i>
Alternative grapheme s, spelt sc	<i>science, scene, disciple, scent, scissors</i>

We will continue to work on words from the Year 3 and 4 National Curriculum word list. You may wish to focus on learning one or two words per week.

**Remember that this list is for the duration of Year 3 and words should be secure by the end of Year 3. Do not attempt to learn these all at once.**
