Summer 1 Mighty Monarchs

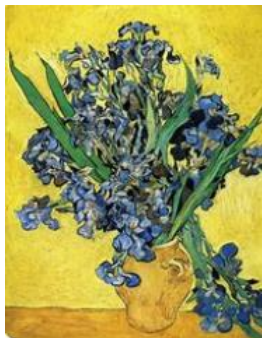
Daily / Weekly

- **Reading:** please read with your child every day and ask them questions to check they understand what they are reading.
 - **Mathletics:** 2 weekly tasks will be set each Tday to support the learning we are doing in class.
- Spellings:** spelling words will be sent home at the start of half term, supporting the spelling patterns we will be learning in class.

Topic related activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

- Using Microsoft Publisher, create your own invitation or magazine front cover.
- Go to the local library and borrow some Little People, Big Dreams biographies. Challenge: Can you write it as an autobiography?
- Time yourself: How many jumping jacks can you do in a minute? How many burpees? Make up your own! Challenge: Do some calculations from your results to predict how many you could do in an hour? Day? Week?
- Keep a diary for a day – note down the times that you do everything. Do the times change at the weekends? Challenge: How much time do you spend in total sleeping? Exercising? Eating?
