Words ending in s /s/ jumps, floats, streets	Words ending in s /z/ trains, spoons, storms
Review words ending –es wishes, torches	<b>Longer words</b> frighten, portrait
Root words with -ing jumping, sleeping	Root words with -ed /t/ helped, smashed
Root words with -ed /id/ /ed/ melted, toasted	Root words with -ed /d/ crowned, groaned
Root words with -er printer, hunter	Root words with -est greenest, freshest

In addition, we will be learning other words, which do not follow a spelling pattern, such as *tricky words*. You may wish to focus on learning a few words per week.
