Daily / Weekly

- **Reading:** please ensure your child is reading for at least 20 minutes a day
- **Spellings:** there are no weekly spelling tests but please support your child with learning weekly spelling patterns that are shared on the website and Seesaw.
- **Maths:** Two Mathletics tasks each week

Topic related activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

No photos or videos of faces to be uploaded to Seesaw

- Work with grown-ups at home to research more amazing facts about Cambridge to present in any way you choose.
- Find non-fiction books at home (or in the local library) about Cambridge. What new facts have you discovered?
- Take a walk around your local area. Can you find any old buildings or places? How do you know they are historic? Take pictures to share with the class.
- Visit a local museum – take photos / write down something you have found out.
- Research the achievements of a locally significant person and present your findings in any way you like.
- Create a word search including some of the Cambridge College names.
- Take part in a reading challenge. Read books about historical adventures and do a book review. How many can you read?
- Interview a family member about how their home town has changed over time – can you find some pictures?
- Design a new feature, building, monument or must see attraction for Cambridge. You could build a 3D model of this.
- Create a quiz all about Cambridge.
- Take a stroll along the River Cam – what can you see?
- Draw and write a story based in and around Cambridge – perhaps your characters can travel back in time.
- How has Caldecote or where you live changed over time? Take a photo of some buildings or places and make a timeline to show the order that they were built.
- Draw a map of where you live or a map of Cambridge to show some significant buildings and places.
- Visit Cambridge’s historic Market Square and buy something – work out which coins to use and how much change you will get.
