Topic related activities

We would like you to complete at least 3 of these (but you can do more!)

- Make a survey to find out why people choose to live where they do and what features they think are important. Ask your family and friends!
- Visit a town or city and compare this with Cambridge. Why do you think people choose to live where they do?
- Find a fictional village/town/city in a book you have read. What features does it have? Could you draw a map of it?
- Go on a treasure hunt or make a treasure hunt for someone (Perhaps have a go at geocaching [Geocaching](#)).
- How could you improve the area in which you live? What ideas do you have?
- Explain how your life would be different if you lived in a different place (a big city, the seaside, on a farm). Why not write a diary entry of a day in a life of you but living somewhere else.
- Go for a long walk using a map to guide your family.
- Research another city from around the world. Which city is your favourite and why?
- Design your own village, town or city (A good opportunity to use some Lego!).
