This half term we will be focusing on the following spelling patterns:

Spelling focus	Example words
Words with silent consonants	knot, know, gnarl, gnat
Words with silent letters	answer, build, business, caught
Revision of Y3 spelling patterns including prefixes, suffixes, and homophones	

We will continue to work on words from the Year 3 and 4 National Curriculum word list. You may wish to focus on learning one or two words per week.

Remember that this list is for the duration of Year 3 and words should be secure by the end of Year 3. Do not attempt to learn these all at once.
