



## September 2021: Outbreak Management Plan

The following measures will be in place at all times from September 2021:

| Ensure good hygiene for everyone – hands and tissues   | See June 2021 Risk Assessment for details of hazards and actions  |
| Additional cleaning of frequently touched surfaces – twice per day                                     |   |
| Occupied spaces kept well ventilated   |   |
| Asymptomatic LFD testing for all staff (until at least the end of September, update from LA to follow) |   |
| Advise all people with Covid-19 symptoms not to attend but to isolate and get a PCR test               |   |
| All those eligible for vaccination (all adults over 18) encouraged to be vaccinated                    | Staff and parents encouraged to receive both doses of vaccination<br>10.09.21 100% of staff double vaccinated |

**NB: Normal operating procedures will be in place for all other areas**

**If the number of cases (PCR positive) within 10 days among children or staff who have mixed closely (not including siblings):**

- **increases rapidly or**
- **there are 5 cases or**
- **10% of the cohort are positive (e.g. in a class with 20 children this would be 2) or**
- **there is a single hospitalisation or death due to covid-19**

**the following measures will be gradually reintroduced in the order below, dependent on the severity of the outbreak. LA will advise.**

| 2 | Reintroduce face coverings in communal areas and on the school site, including for parents  |  |
| 3 | Reintroduce measures to reduce mixing - class bubbles, careclub bubbles, lunchtime hall bubbles, cancel extra-curricular activities, no assemblies, max 5 adults in staffroom, one-way system on playground.<br>This is most disruptive step, hence last to be introduced |  |
